# Show Rules and Regulations

1. The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the B.F.A.
2. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
3. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and running order.
4. No person shall impugn the decisions of the Head Judge or Judges.
5. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
1. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
2. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
  - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
  - b. A danger to safety of any person or animal
  - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
3. All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
4. **All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.**
5. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
6. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
7. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.
8. **NO BARBEQUES TO BE USED DIRECTLY ON THE GRASS**
9. Starters will be run based on current BFA rules. Jump heights and assistance at the box are left to the discretion of individual teams, based on the ability of their team. **Any Non BFA Members competing in Starters are the responsibility of the Primary Team Captain.**

## Directions

### **From the South:**

From Edinburgh on A90 over Forth Road Bridge

Continue on to M90 for 28.7 miles

Road changes to A90

Stay on A90 for 15.5 miles

Slip left towards Dryburgh Ind Est/ Lochee/Coupar Angus.

1st exit R/B onto A923/ Couper Angus Road

1st exit R/B, then turn right into Camperdown Park

Follow road following Flyball signs

### **From the West:**

A9 Stirling to Perth

Join A90 at Broxden R/B at Perth

Follow above directions.

### **From the North:**

A90 to Dundee.

At Forfar Road Junction turn right onto A90 (towards Perth).

Straight ahead for two roundabouts.

Branch left, then at roundabout take the third exit onto A923 (signposted Camperdown Country park).

Follow Flyball signs.
