- 1. The tournament organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to any person not in good standing with the B.F.A.
- 1. No person shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the tournament.
- 2. It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure the Team is available for its class and check the running order.
- 3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4. A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
 - b. A danger to safety of any person or animal
 - c. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 5. All dogs enter into the tournament at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 6. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue.
- 7. B.F.A. rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.
- 8. No alcohol is to be consumed within or around the ring.
- 9. NO BARBEQUES TO BE USED DIRECTLY ON THE GRASS
- 10. Starters, if held, will be run based on current BFA rules. Jump heights and assistance at the box are left to the discretion of individual teams, based on the ability of their team. Any Non BFA Members competing in Starters are the responsibility of the Primary Team Captain.
- 11. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 12. If circumstances make it necessary that the tournament is cancelled, the organisers reserve the right to defray expenses incurred by deducting such expenses from entry fees received.
