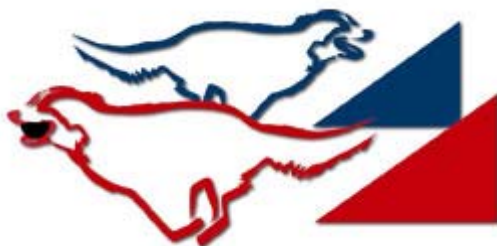

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

Newark Showground, Lincoln Road, Winthorpe, Newark, Notts NG24 2NY

- 1 The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entry and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing with the BFA.
- 2 No person shall carry out punitive or harsh treatment of a dog whilst at the event.
- 3 Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area. Mating of dogs is not allowed.
- 4 A dog must be withdrawn from competition if it is:
 - a) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
 - b) A danger to safety of any person or animal
 - c) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
- 5 It is the Team Captains responsibility to ensure that the Team is available for their class and running order.
- 6 The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 7 All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the Event Organiser(s) cannot accept responsibility for damage, injury or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
- 8 All dog owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue. Please use designated exercise areas.
- 9 BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the Sanctioned Tournament.
- 10 All teams entering either show are expected to assist with ring party duties as requested to by the tournament organiser.
- 11 As this is a public show, there is to be no movement of vehicles between the hours of 9am and 6pm, anyone wishing to move their vehicles between these times must park in the public car park.
